WHAT IS FIELD HOCKEY?

Field Hockey is a unique sport played by both men and women around the world. It combines the skills of soccer with all the disciplines of hockey.

The modern game of field hockey originated in the 19th century England. In 1901 Constance Applebee introduced the sport to the United States. In 1922, the United States Field Hockey Association was formed. Women's field hockey became an Olympic sport in 1980.

A field hockey team consists of 11 players including a goalkeeper. The ball must be moved down the field using the flat side of the stick. A goal is scored when an attacker strikes the ball into the goal from within the striking circle.

- Also feeds Team Golden Triangle, the premier Western Pa club for elite competition on the National level.

AND...The YWCA Program opens the door for players to advance to the USFHA FUTURES Program. Some YW players have advanced to play at Penn, Cornell, Seton Hill U, Juniata, Robert Morris and U of Maryland and the Futures Elite Academy Program for Olympic Development.
